# Standardisation Working Group

The convener of this working group is Kelvis Kasonkomona and deputy is Roy Wienand, but as neither were available, the feedback presentation was done by Kgopisho Mahunonyane and he emphasised the primary points of discussion from the WG that no document management process (DMP) exists in the PIESA, and in addition, they believe, that the website should be used more extensively to manage and control input from WG representatives.

The WG has undertaken to have an effective DMP in place by February 2011.

#### Non Technical loss reduction

The workgroup nominated Mr Macvittie Chiphwanya as the new convener of this workgroup and Mr L Chisina as the deputy, which was ratified and approved by the Board.



The primary goal for the current year is to conduct the prepaid metering training early in November 2010, and distribute DVD's throughout the region by next year; In addition, DMS will be considered and promoted in the region.

#### **Board decisions**

Some of the significant resolutions taken by the board, include the following:

• A PIESA policy will be drawn up to encourage more affiliate member participation in the PIESA working groups

- That the PIESA Secretariat draws up a policy document for approval by the board whereby one staff member of a full utility member of the PIESA will be sponsored to attend an IERE technical forum each year. It was further noted, that as executive members of IERE, all PIESA members may attend any IERE event at their own cost at the reduced members registration fee
- It was agreed that the Board will nominate suitably qualified staff members to serve on the technical committees of AFSEC
- The strategic plan for 2010-12 was approved by the board, subject to flexibility in the WG action plans, which may be changed by the board subject to prevailing circumstances
- That the 2011 PIESA biennial Africa forum would be hosted by Escom Malawi

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#### PIESA MEMBERSHIP

The recruiting of new members has been slow, but is gradually paying dividends.

Interest in membership of PIESA is clearly on the increase – The participation of the Rural Electrification Authorities from Zimbabwe and Kenya as affiliate members is significant, and clearly demonstrates a growing recognition of PIESA in the region. While suppliers of equipment and materials continue to express an interest in joining as affiliates, but has been seriously affected by the economic downturn around the world.

Our big challenge is to draw in those electricity distributors in the regions that are not yet members, and those whose memberships have lapsed. The secretariat has the prime responsibility to make that happen, and have gradually seen a response from utilities that have been visited recently.

Botswana Power corporation have expressed positive interest in joining PIESA and they can see considerable value for their members to participate in the working groups .

The Mocambique Electricity Supply Company, 'EDM', have been approached, and they are currently considering to join PIESA, the COO will visit them early in the new year to present the credentials of the PIESA

As stated by the PIESA Chairman in his annual report, it is incumbent upon all PIESA members to market the benefits' of PIESA membership where we interact with our colleagues in neighbouring utilities to promote membership of PIESA.

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#### **TRAINING**

#### SWER practical implementation

REA in Zimbabwe decided to implement a rural electrification project which has proved to be a remarkable success. This will be expanded into other Countries in the region.

# **Prepayment Metering**

PIESA Non technical loss reduction working group resolved to request authorisation from the board to conduct a prepayment metering training project. Following on from the success of the IERE legacy SWER training DVD, it was agreed that another video would be made of the prepaid metering training course.
